

Loan Periods:

Books & Pamphlets – 21 days

Periodicals, Reference Books & Audiovisual materials are LIBRARY USE ONLY

Reserve Materials – Specified by instructor

Interlibrary Loans – Varies; Specified on item

Intralibrary Loans – Varies; Specified on item

Renewals are limited to one renewal period, and are allowed only if no one has requested the item. Renewals may be made online, in person, or by phone (302-453-3716).

Fines, etc.:

Books, pamphlets - \$.015 per day per item

Reserve materials - \$2.00 per day per item

It is the borrower's obligation to be aware of due dates. Failure to receive an overdue notice does not excuse the borrower from returning books and paying fines.

Lost and/or damaged materials must be paid for at market value, plus a \$10 handling charge per item for cataloged books and best sellers. (Writing and/or highlighting in the books is considered damage).

Students: Transcripts will not be released nor registration or graduation allowed until all library obligations have been met.

Borrower Registration:

Students: your valid Delaware Tech ID card must be presented each time you want to use library materials, including reserves and “Library Use Only” items. New students can obtain an ID card from the Public Safety Office (Room A132). ID cards are validated by the Public Safety Office each semester. The library will attach a barcode number to your ID card, thus also making it your library card. You may use your valid Delaware Tech ID card at any Delaware Tech campus library, the University of Delaware library and Delaware State University library.

Faculty/Staff: must present a valid Delaware Tech ID card to check out library materials.

UD Associate in Arts students, faculty and staff: may borrow with a valid Delaware Tech ID.

Delaware State University and UD students: may borrow with a university ID card and registration receipt for the current semester or a letter of introduction from their library.

Community Residents: persons 18 years or older, who live or work in Delaware, may register with the Stanton Campus Library as a community resident borrower upon presentation of appropriate ID.
