




## Library Modules for Delaware Tech Students

TILT is the nickname of the Texas Information Literacy Tutorial, developed by the University of Texas. You will be able to complete your TILT library module requirement using any computer with Internet access and a printer. There are three modules and three quizzes that must be completed with a score of 85% or above. Your instructor will assign the due date.

### ACCESSING and NAVIGATING TILT

1. Go to the URL <http://tilt.lib.utsystem.edu/>
2. On the first screen, read the information then click on **TILT Lite** (no plug-ins required)
3. After reading the next screen, click on 
4. At the registration screen click on **First Time Visitors**
5. Fill in the registration form. (Select **Other School** for the University) click on **Register**
6. Follow the on screen instructions until you see the screen listing the **Intro, Module 1, Module 2, Module 3**. To begin a **Module** click on the corresponding link
7. At the end of the module either click on **Quiz me** to start the quiz or **Can I review?** to go back through any part of the module before taking the quiz

**If your quiz results total 85% or above, print copies of your Quiz Summary as follows:**

all students--one copy for your instructor, one copy for your records  
only Stanton & Wilmington Campus students-- also one copy for your campus library

- **WARNING! TILT does not keep records. You must print your Quiz summary when you have it on the screen. You cannot go back later and retrieve it. Also, the email option often fails.**
8. **If you score less than 85%, retake the quiz before submitting results.** Quiz results under 85% will not fulfill your library module requirement
  9. To continue with another module after the quiz, click on TILT to return
  10. If you exit before completing all three modules, sign in as a Return Visitor for your next session

**You have completed your TILT Library Module requirement when you have delivered copies of quiz summaries of 85% or better for each of the three modules to your instructor.**
